Where Do My School Tax Dollars Go?

Assessed value of property = \$100,000. The \$100,000 is divided by 100 for tax calculations. The school tax rate of $$1.1031 \times 1000 = $1,103.10$. This goes for:

- \$ 0.00 (.00%) goes to the **EDUCATION FUND.** This fund pays salaries and benefits for teachers, aides, clerical, and administrators. This fund also pays for insurance (health, life, LTD, and vision), Social Security, retirement, professional services, and instructional materials. The current rate is .0000.
- \$563.90 (48.67%) goes to the **OPERATIONS FUND.** This fund pays salaries and benefits of central office, maintenance, custodial and transportation staff. It also pays for fuel as well as maintenance of buildings, repair of buses, and new buses. The current rate is .5369.
- \$566.20 (51.33%) goes to the **DEBT SERVICE FUND.** This fund is used to pay back the money borrowed to build or remodel buildings. The current rate is .5662. In 2020 this amount is allocated as follows:
 - \$ 47.10 2009 JE Ober Renovation (will be paid off in 2020)
 - 8.93 Interest of Temporary Loans
 - 10.07 Textbook Rental Assistance
 - 424.92 2009 BAB High School (will be paid off in 2028)
 - 28.91 2014A JE Ober 2 Million Bond (will be paid off in 2030)
 - 28.63 2014B GHS 2 Million Bond (will be paid off in 2030)
 - 17.64 2019 Series Bond (will be paid off in 2032)
- \$ 0.00 (.00%) goes to the **RAINY DAY FUND**. This fund is used to pay expenses as established by written resolution of the School Board. The current rate is .0000.
