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## BRING YOUR OWN APPLE DEVICE (BYOAD) PROGRAM

***The Bring Your Own Apple Device*** program is an optional program offered to any student attending Garrett-Keyser-Butler CSD during the 2021-22 school year. The BYOAD program will replace the school issued device (iPad 5<sup>th</sup> Gen) for those who choose to enroll.

- Parents have the following options in regards to obtaining the required technology device for their student:
  - Choose to pay the full textbook rental fee and the student will be issued a school device
  - Enroll your student in the BYOAD program following the provisions below

### ***iPad - Grades K-8***

Provisions for acceptance into the BYOAD program:

- \*Acceptable devices for any student in grades K-8 include iPads with 9.7 inch screen as required for state testing (***iPad Mini is no longer an acceptable BYOAD Device***):
  - iPad – 5<sup>th</sup> Generation or newer
  - iPad Air – iPad Air 2 or newer
  - iPad Pro – any Generation and size
- Any student enrolled in the Garrett-Keyser-Butler CSD Bring Your Own Apple Device Program in the past must re-enroll each school year

Guidelines for participating in the program:

1. Parents interested in participating in the program should enroll into the program by:
  - Completing the section of the 2021-2022 school year online student registration stating you would like to enroll your child into the BYOAD program.
2. Parents acquire an acceptable device (listed above).
  - a. \*Device shall stay in good working order throughout the duration of the school year in regards to performance and software updates
3. Parents are encouraged to provide a protective case for the device.
4. Parents agree to allow the GKB Management Application software to be installed on the personal device.
  - a. ***Parents/Students are responsible to purchase & install software/Apps that are needed to complete course work on a BYOAD device.***
5. The Textbook Rental fees owed for the 2021-2022 school year will ***not*** include the rental cost of the iPad for students participating in the program. The remaining fees will apply.
6. Parents are responsible for upkeep of the device and should seek repairs to damaged equipment at the store where the equipment was purchased or 3<sup>rd</sup> Party Repair Shops.
  - a. School district personnel are not permitted to work on hardware issues of personal devices.
7. Parents understand if for any reason a student is unable to bring their device to school, they must rent a school owned device and are obligated to pay \$1.00 fee for each school day. An invoice will be created and mailed to parents for the rental fee.

- The terms and conditions stated above in the *Bring Your Own Apple Device Program* offered by Garrett-Keyser-Butler CSD for the 2020-2021 school year
- The district's Student Education Technology Acceptable Use and Safety Policy as presented and signed off on during online registration
- Garrett-Keyser-Butler CSD does not accept any liability of the parent owned device
